



PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play because you enjoy football, not to please your parent or coach
- Players must respect the rights, dignity & worth of each & every person & treat them equally within the context of the sport
- Players must adhere to all guidelines laid down by the constitution & the code of conduct of the club
- Players must develop an appropriate working relationship with the Manager / Coach based on mutual trust and respect
- Players must accept responsibility for their own behaviour & performance
- Players should, at the outset, clarify with the Manager / Coach exactly what is expected of them and also, what they are entitled to expect from other players.
- Players are expected to be punctual for training & matches & have the appropriate equipment ie: Shin pads & Football boots
- Players are discouraged from entering into disputes with the referee, his assistants, opposing parents / guardians / spectators or players
- Players must always adhere to the positive aspects of the sport & never condone violations of the laws of the game, or behave contrary to the spirit of the laws of the game or relevant rules & regulations, or use prohibited substances or techniques
- Players must appreciate the importance of striving to win not winning itself
